

Karlsruhe University of Education, Japanese language course: 12 students, 3 teachers Faculty of Education, Gifu University: 10 students, 3 teachers, 4 administrators After a brief explanation of the flow of the meeting, Dr Ralph Hansmann, Lecturer in Physics at the Karlsruhe University of Education, gave an opening address in Japanese and the second online exchange meeting began.

First, all participants did a warm-up exercise with an explanation of the functions of the BigBlueButton. Afterwards, the participants were divided into groups of four and introduced themselves to each other, sharing photos they had prepared.

Next followed a presentation by three students from the Japanese Language Course 2 at the Karlsruhe University of Education. The presentation was given in English with plenty of photos about Karlsruhe and the Karlsruhe University of Education conveying its charms in abundance. The Gifu students' interest in Karlsruhe University of Education must have been piqued.



After that everyone introduced themselves in English at the beginning of a presentation by students from the Faculty of Education at Gifu University. Then the presentation was given with lots of graphs and figures to give an insight into life at Gifu University.





After the presentations, group activities were held again discussing 'similarities and differences between Karlsruhe University of Education and Gifu University'. After the group activity, students shared some similarities. For example, both universities are located in the city centre, with shops and restaurants nearby, and both offer sports and other club activities. Differences included the number of students, the tuition fees, the number of days per week students attending university, and the timing of when to decide about which type of school they are going to teach at after graduation.



Afterwards, it was introduced that there was a group for Japanese-German exchange on the closed campus website of the Karlsruhe University of Education, and that the participants were welcome to join.



It was also announced that students from Gifu University could participate in the online Japanese language course held by Migiwa Inoue-Gramlich at the Karlsruhe University of Education on 1 July.

The meeting was closed with a speech in German by Prof Yukihiro Nomura, Chairman of the International Relationships Committee of the Faculty of Education of Gifu University.



It was a good opportunity for students from both universities to get to know each other, and we hope that exchanges will deepening further in the future.
